

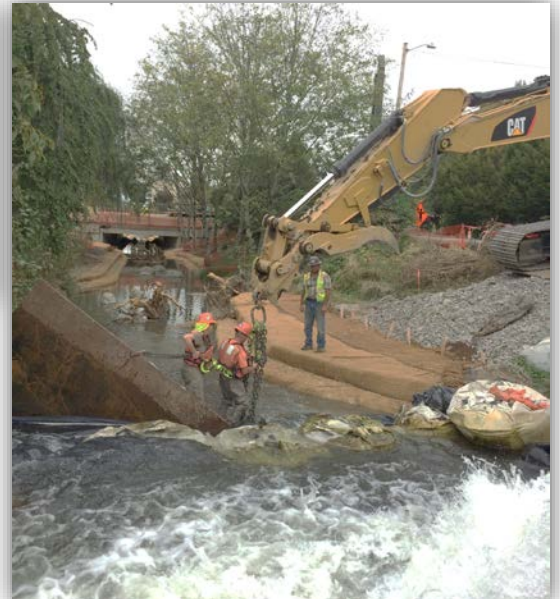

MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS



ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES
CITY OF PORTLAND

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Last fiscal year BES spent eighty-seven million dollars, around eighty percent of total budget, in capital programs and major projects.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Constructed 7,000 feet of new sanitary sewer on **SW Terwilliger Blvd & Powers Ct.**
- Began design on the **CBWTP Biogas Utilization**, a project to develop renewable natural gas on site at the Waste Treatment Plant.
- Improved the Tualatin Hills Trail between **Fanno Creek Bridge and SW 909th Ave.**
- Restored 300 feet of stream channel and one and a half acres of wetland on the **Lower Errol Heights Stream.**
- Replaced culverts in Crystal Springs Creek for **SE Bybee St. and SE Glenwood St.** supporting a healthier watershed.
- Continued the **Large-Scale Sewer Rehabilitation Program**, to update and replace sewer mains and laterals in residential areas citywide.
- Protected key habitat for birds and mammals by acquiring and restoring property on **Veteran’s Creek.**
- Updated the **CBWTP Facilities Plan**, focusing on wet weather treatment performance and capacity.
- Partnered with Trimet to coordinate downtown sewer repairs on **Yamhill and Morrison** during MAX line repair to minimize impact.
- Improved the performance of the Water Quality Facility located with McKinley Estates on **SE Platt Ave.**
- Created an IGA with Multnomah County to replace and rehabilitate sewers next to the **Multnomah County Courthouse**

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UPCOMING WORK

- Continuing to refine requirements for upgrades to **CBWTP** and **TCWTP** to establish more robust cost and schedule estimates.
- Soon **CBWTP** will be more aesthetically pleasing from the public walking trail.
- **Portsmouth and University Park** neighborhoods are having their highly-deteriorated sewers replaced or rehabilitated, increasing overall capacity.
- Replacing the **Tryon Creek** Interceptor sewer from the TCWTP headworks.
- A Renovation to expand the **Water Pollution Control Lab**, as well as updating it to current ADA regulations.
- Large Scale Sewer Rehab Projects starting construction: **City wide, Tabor Powell II, Richmond South Tabor, Concordia, Woodlawn King Streets, Woodlawn King Alley's, N Montavilla & S Montavilla**
- In construction: **Hollywood Grant Park, Tabor, Powell and CIPP SE, Humboldt, Mt. Scott-Arleta and Woodstock Sewer Repair** projects.
- Entering design: small diameter program, **Hillsdale, South Portland Burlingame, Council-Crest, Goose Hollow, Arbor lodge -Kenton and Mill Caruthers in the Downtown Old Town** program.
- Planning for large diameter pipe projects has been going on for around a year and a half.
