

## Mount Tabor Reservoirs

### Historic Preservation Project

In 2015 Council Resolution #37146 directed the Water Bureau to work with the Mount Tabor Neighborhood Association to prioritize the historic preservation construction projects specified in the *2009 Mt. Tabor Historic Structures Report (HSR)*, for which Council committed to allocating \$4 million in general funds over the ensuing four years.

#### Reservoir 5 Work

- **Completed:** Gatehouse concrete restoration and new fence at dam face
- **Planned:** parapet wall restoration, HypoChlorite concrete cleaning, Gatehouse and Hypochlorite roof, window and door repairs

#### Reservoir 6 Work

- **Completed:** Inlet/Outlet Gatehouse concrete restoration
- **Planned:** parapet wall restoration, Gatehouse roof, window and door repairs

#### Reservoir 1 Work

- **Completed:** Concrete restoration work south parapet wall, walkway, and weir building; Weir Building window repair and roof replacement, fountain preservation
- **In progress:** Reservoir 1 concrete basin repairs
- **Planned:** Complete gutter wall repairs, Gatehouse roof, window and door repairs

#### Other work under consideration

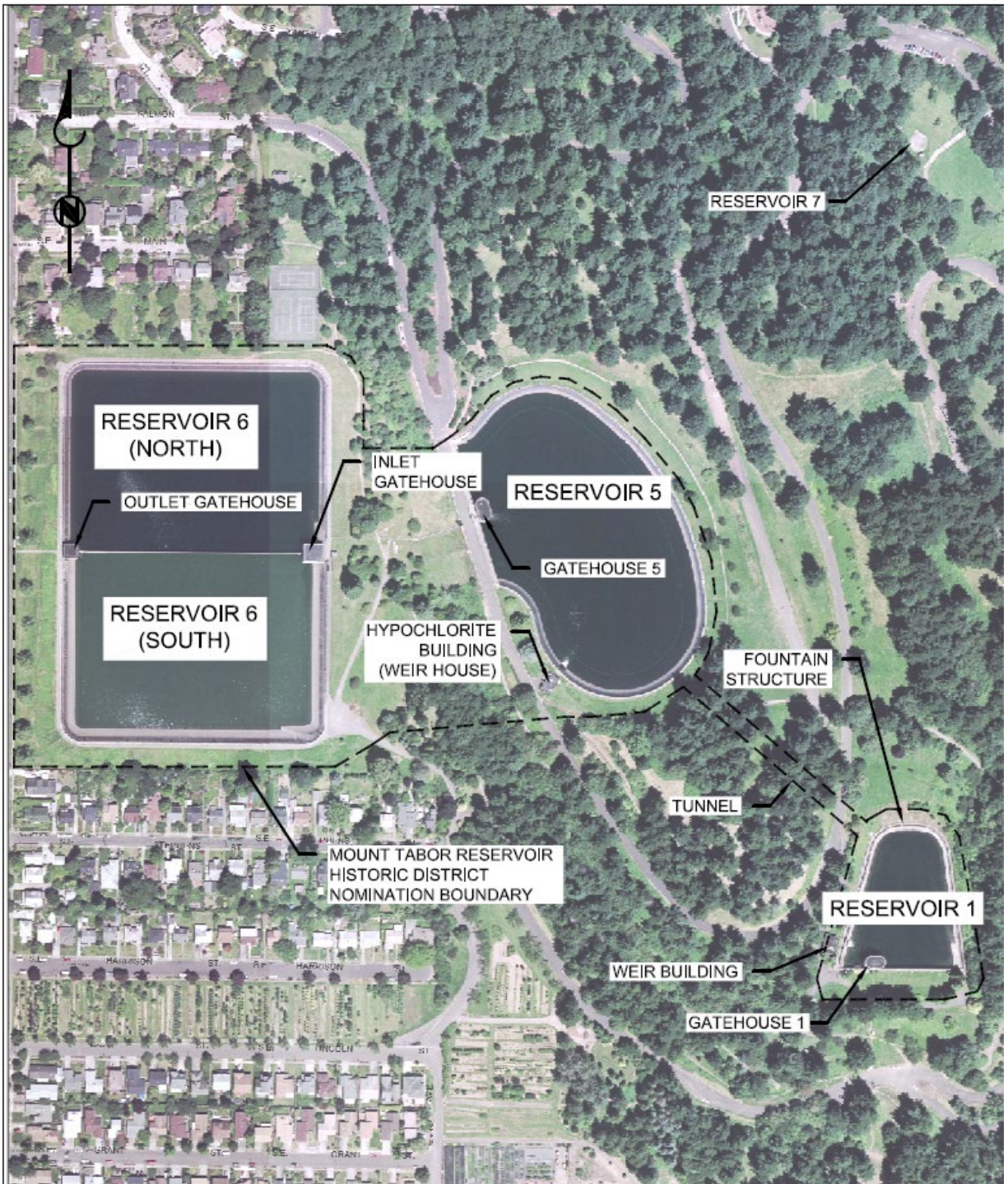
- Fence and tapered tower repairs/reconstruction
- Fence lighting restoration (if adequate funding available)
- Balcony repairs
