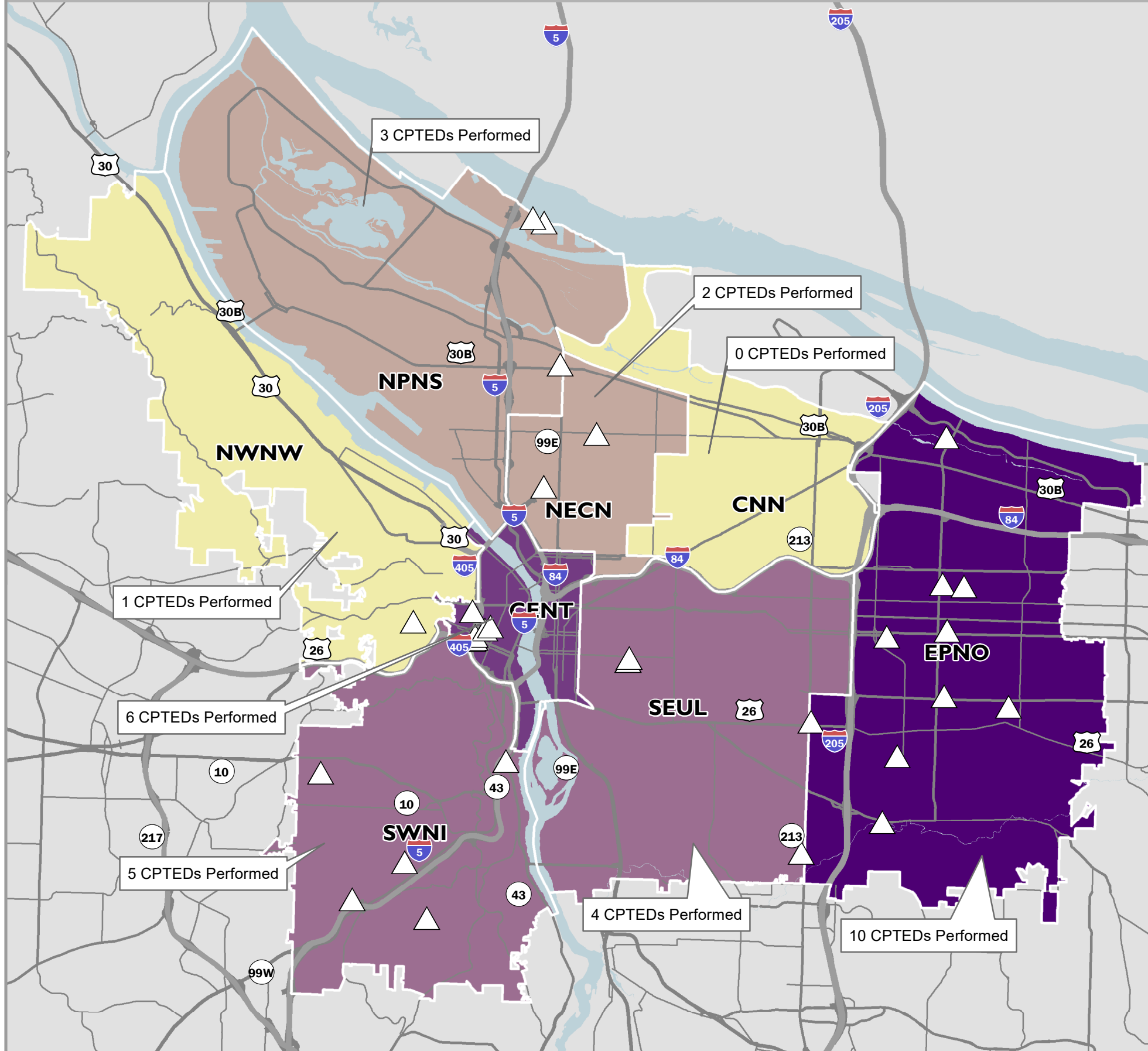

Overview

Portland's public safety education services are offered through the City of Portland, Office of Community & Civic Life's, Community Safety Program. These services are provided by three teams of Community Safety Coordinators who are assigned to neighborhoods throughout the city. The Program organizes and supports partnerships to build safe communities that are connected, inclusive, and engaged. The services fall into three broad areas: public safety education, community organizing, and connecting community to a broad range of public safety resources. Level of Service

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) is the proper design and effective use of the built and social environment to achieve a more productive use of space and a reduction of crime. A CPTED assessment is helpful to help identify landscaping, lighting, or other security vulnerabilities and environmental factors that may be attracting criminal or other problem activity. Community Safety Coordinators provide free site assessments and make recommendations to address safety concerns and support placemaking and positive activities. When the recommendations are provided to the responsible party, it is up to the property manager or owner to determine what recommendations are implemented. 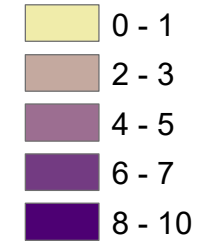
Map Discussion
