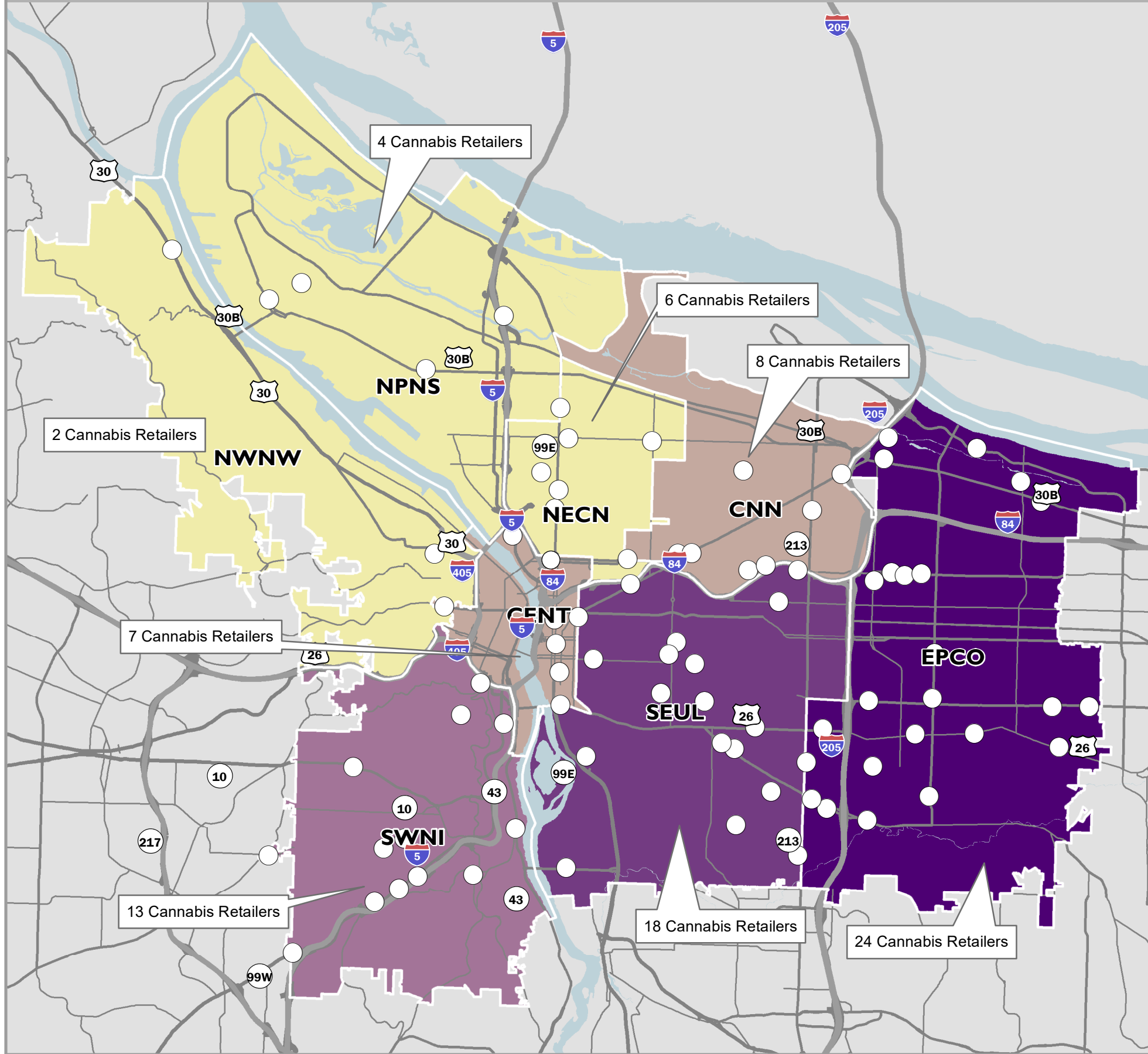


City of Portland Cannabis Program

BUREAU NOTES

Overview

The City of Portland Cannabis Program is housed within the Office of Community & Civic Life. The Cannabis Program is tasked with licensing, regulation, and enforcement of all cannabis businesses with the Portland city limits. In partnership with the community and the cannabis industry, the Cannabis Program leads Portland's cannabis policy to ensure neighborhood livability and economic development for Portland businesses.

Level of Service

The Cannabis Program has two compliance specialists organized geographically who monitor 7 kinds of regulations in coordination with multiple city Bureaus, e.g. Bureau of Development Services (BDS), Portland Police Bureau (PPB), Portland Fire Bureau (PFB), Bureau of Revenue and the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC)

To better support licensees in navigating the complexities specific to opening a licensed cannabis business, we regularly communicate and coordinate with the following agencies and City bureaus: 1. Zoning and Land Use Permits, (BDS, OLCC) 2. Building and Product Security (with PPB), 3. Building Code Safety and Permits (PFB, BDS), 4. Licensing (OLCC), 5. Complaints (Trash, Noise, Odor, Public Consumption, Land Use), 6. Enforcement of unregulated businesses (OLCC, Oregon State Police), and 7. Point of Sale and Banking Systems (OLCC, Revenue).

Map Discussion

This map depicts locations of marijuana retailers who have applied for and have been granted a Marijuana Regulatory License in FY19-20. Marijuana Retailers are required by Portland City Code 14B.130 to be at least 1000 feet away from Medical Dispensaries, other Marijuana Retailers, as well as public or private K-12 schools.
