## **TRN-14.33 – SEASONAL PERMITS.**

*Administrative Rule Adopted by Portland Bureau of Transportation Pursuant to Rule-Making Authority Portland City Code 16.40.970*

- I. Recommendations for rule adoption and code revisions. At the recommendation of the PFHT Advisory Committee, the Director may adopt administrative rules pursuant to Chapter 16.40.970 and may provide to the Bureau Commissioner-in-Charge a recommendation to revise any sections here within Chapter 16.40.

Under the authority of 16.40.970, I am adopting Administrative Rule TRN-14.33 to provide seasonal certification option for Executive Town Car and LPT Vehicles. All vehicles are subject the requirements of Chapter 16.40, Private for-Hire Transportation.

### **Executive Town Car & LPT Seasonal Permits**

LPT Vehicle Seasonal Permits can be issued to companies that operate Private for-Hire Transportation services for up to four months out of the year. All companies requesting a seasonal permit for vehicles must have a valid PFHT company permit issued. There are no seasonal permit options for company permits.

Seasonal permits for LPT motorized vehicles are billed at \$100.00 and expire after four months from the date they are issued. These permits may not be issued beyond the expiration date of the company permit.

All vehicles rented, leased or owned, are subject to all the requirements of the vehicle certification process outlined in chapter 16.40. Seasonal permits are issued to a specific vehicle identification number (VIN) and are only transferable through the standard vehicle replacement process.

Seasonal permits will not be issued to rented or leased vehicles with rental/lease contract restrictions, of any kind, regarding private for-hire use.

Seasonal permit fees may not be credited towards acquiring a full year permit. Any additional permitting will be done so at a prorated amount to bring the end date of the vehicle permit in accordance with the company permit.
