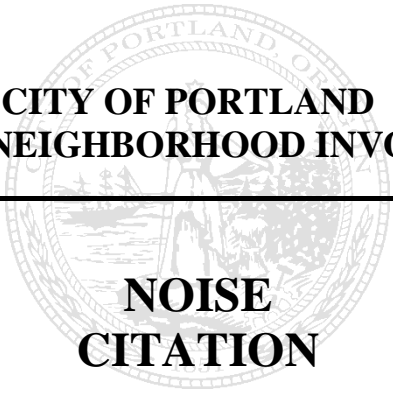

VIOLATION DESCRIPTIONS:

Responsible party: When a violation of the Noise Code is observed, an ONI Noise Inspector may issue a citation to the person or persons responsible for the violation (responsible party). The responsible party may be the noisemaker or the property owner. When no other responsible party can be identified, the property owner is the responsible party. Regardless, a copy of this citation will be sent to the property owner.

Fines and corrections: Fines are due even when the violation is corrected.

Appeals: If the responsible party thinks this citation has been issued in error, an Administrative Review may be filed. The first level of administrative review is to the Office of Neighborhood Involvement. The written review must be received within 15 days of the issued date on this citation. An Administrative Review Appeal Fee of \$110 is due when the written request for an Administrative Review is requested. This fee will only be refunded if it is determined that all of the contested violations were cited in error. The written request, along with the \$110 Administrative Review Fee, must be hand-delivered or mailed to:

Violation Descriptions:

1. Violations classified as Residential, Open Space, Commercial, or Industrial in their description relate to the Land Use Zone in which the noise violation occurs. These Land Use Zones are further defined in the Definition section (EE) of Title 18.04.040 of the Portland City Code. Commercial operations creating noise violations at homes or businesses in Residential Land Use Zones shall be considered a Commercial violation for the purpose of a citation with the City of Portland.
2. Construction on a homeowner's home, by the homeowner herself or himself shall be considered a residential violation. All other construction work on a property by non-homeowners, or professional contractors, shall be considered a Construction violation for the purposes of a citation from the Noise Control Department.
3. If an individual does not possess a proper noise variance, a citation will be issued based on the Land Use Zone in which the excessive noise source is located. (Noise Variance applications are available from Noise Control at the address listed at the bottom of this page.) The City will use the zoning classifications noted above, taken from the definitions (EE) section of Title 18 to determine the appropriate description or category of the violation.

Per day fines: Per day fines continue from the date on the citation until such day as the inspector determines that the violation has been corrected. It is the responsibility of the responsible party to call the inspector when the violation is corrected. The inspector will then re-inspect the property and determine if the violation has been corrected.

Deadlines before fines double: When a responsible party has failed to pay the citation fines within 30 days of the date on the citation, or within 15 days of the final review of the Director or an appealed citation, the fine(s) indicated on the citation will be doubled.

Non-payment of fines: Where a violation has been corrected and subsequently approved by the Noise Inspector, but the responsible party has neglected to pay the fines, no further noise variances will be issued to that responsible party until such fines are paid.

Payments: Checks should be made payable to "ONI Noise Compliance Program." To assure proper credit of the payment, the ***Serial Number on the face of this citation should be included on the check, and a copy of the citation form returned with payment.***
