**Questionnaire 1 - 4**

1. Wild West Emporium, Sandy Blvd will continue to maintain compliance with all State and City licensing guidelines set forth by OAR 845 Division 25 regulations and all City of Portland regulations. We have all signage posted clearly and conspicuously. Minors are not permitted anywhere on premises, we actively enforce this by asking that valid ID be shown by every patron and medical card holder. Our store has signage outlining the risk factors of marijuana use by minors as well as the small informational cards from the OHA warning against use while pregnant or allowing accidental ingestion by children. Our employees are trained on a consistent basis on how to spot real vs false identification and what forms of ID are acceptable. We have signage at our front desk outlining these forms of ID as well as key indicators behind the desk to help spot if an ID may be false.
2. We post signage on the way out of the store that states marijuana products may not be consumed on site or in public. We monitor our immediate parking area in the front of the building to ensure customers are being respectful of the laws in place.
3. Our business is located in a neighborhood in NE Portland. We work hard to maintain a clean parking area and frontage for the retail space. We do not leave garbage outside and service regularly picks up each week. The store does not play any loud music or have noise emanating from the building, and there are "no loitering" and "no solicitation" signs posted by the front door.
4. We welcome our neighboring business owners and residents (21 years of age and older) to come into our store and speak with our store manager or ask for the company HR representative to discuss any concerns or questions. We have business cards available for contact information. Any time we are open to the public we welcome our community to come by. If complaints arise we will immediately notify the licensee/business owner so he may become involved at a higher level to resolve whatever concern is presented.
