We have the OHA/OLCC required signs posted in plain site upon entry of the retail facility lobby/check-in area , informing people of the age rules (21 and over). Our staff has been trained to inspect identification for each person entering the retail facility, ensuring anyone entering the facility is at least 21 years of age or older. Our lobby area is separated from the dispensary area by walls and a door. We ensure every customer is given the state issued warning card upon each purchase which explains the potential risks of marijuana use by minors

We have posted the state mandated poster "Educate before you Recreate" which informs customers of the rules involved around recreational marijuana use. Our employees have been trained on these rules and regulations and are able to inform our customers during their visit to our facility.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

We ensure our dispensary is not only a safe, clean and welcoming establishment for our patrons but also serves as a respectable business that is an asset to our community. Thurman Street Collective serves as a full functioning Art Gallery in which we feature local artist in a non exclusive environment. 90% of all art sales go straight to the artist, the remaining 10% is donated to our neighborhood community center (Friendly House). We ensure all interior and exterior premises are kept clean on a regular basis.
