**1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.**

We have OLC compliant signs posted. The signs are size 8.5" x 11" + letters 1/2" in height, posted in both English + Spanish at our store entrance and at our retail department entrance stating, "NO Minors Allowed," and "Medical Marijuana Patients and Persons 21 and Older permitted," and "No persons under 21 permitted on these premises without an MMMP card." Our personnel are trained to follow our strict guidelines for examining valid identification in the reception area. The staff verifies it's valid ID, + the patron looks like picture on ID. All sales associates reconfirm identification for every transaction.

**2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.**

We have signs posted to prevent consumption on premises and in public. These signs are posted at our entry and within our interior.

Upon entry of our facility, all new patrons must review our terms that's displayed at the reception desk and at every register. The membership terms explain proper handling and safe use of products, no lingering, no littering, no loitering within premises and streets, and respectful interactions with all staffs patrons, and neighbors. We continuously monitor patrons at all times while they are within our facility. We ensure they are in presence of staff at all times. Staff stops all loitering or lingering.

**3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.**

Maintaining positive relationships + safe environment for the neighborhood is a top priority. Investment in the property which includes planting more hedging plants where people can possibly loiter to decrease visibility. Waste + recycling receptacles will be provided to prevent littering.

Staff periodically walks through grounds and picks up litter.

Signage is posted to remind individuals to not consume on premises + state regulations do not permit cannabis consumption anywhere in public.

We always welcome any feedback + concerns. We believe in having an open dialogue with neighboring businesses and working together will assist in keeping our neighborhood safe, clean and reduce any negative impacts.
