1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

We check all ID's prior to allowing customers to enter the facility, as mandated by the state. We also double check the ID at time of transaction. It is posted outside of the facility that no one under the age of 21 is allowed to enter the building unless they have an OMMP card.

We include a card with every purchase stating that the product needs to be kept out of reach of minors, as mandated by the state. Also, each product is marked with "For use only by adults 21 and older. Kept out of reach of children. This package is not child resistant. Do not drive a motor vehicle while under the influence of marijuana. This product is not approved by the FDA to treat, cure, or prevent any disease.

2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.

It is posted outside of Gram Central Station that no on-site consumption of products containing cannabis is allowed. We also have the "Educate Before You Recreate" sign in place in our facility as mandated by the state. This sign encourages patrons to research the laws before consuming their medicine. Customers are reminded that public consumption is not legal and marijuana products must be consumed inside the safety and privacy of their own residence.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

Gram Central Station has its own secure parking lot, as well as additional parking within the neighborhood that is low impact to the neighborhood. If we see anything occurring in our parking area that should not be happening we immediately address the concern by asking the patron to stop or leave.

We have garbage cans for our patrons inside the facility and in our parking lot; as well as an ashtray for patrons that smoke cigarettes.

Noise is not an issue from our facility as we are not generating any noise and only have industrial buildings surrounding us.

4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.

We don't anticipate any complaints about our facility as we have a good relationship with the businesses and residential members of our neighborhood around us. If there were a complaint about us we would ask for it in writing and then do everything we could to address the concerns of the complainant in a manner that was best for all parties involved.
