- 1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.
- Everyone that comes in has their ID checked and scanned for verification purposes, personal information is not retained per Oregon law
- Mandatory "no minors allowed" signed posted on facility entrance
- Doors to the sales floor are locked at all times to maintain security and control the flow of people
- No one is admitted to the sales floor without valid ID
- Customers' ID is checked again at time of sale to verify
- We have uploaded several blog posts to our website that provide information on legal and safe use
- We will include similar information in email newsletters
- Required signage on keeping marijuana away from minors has been posted throughout the store to educate customers
- All packaging of products we sell will meet OLCC packaging/labeling standards and will contain the "keep away from children" warning
- We provide the informational card as required by OLCC warning customers of the dangers of allowing children access to cannabis

- 2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.
- We regulate the flow of people onto the sales floor to ensure that there is only one budtender per customer so that customers may be monitored
- Larger groups are broken up to limit the amount of people on the sales floor at any one time
- Required signage is posted in and about the premises to remind customers that it is illegal to consume cannabis products on the premises or in public
- A stationary letter is posted at the front desk to remind customers of state laws and rules for legal cannabis consumption
- Employees are trained to monitor exterior cameras and look for customers lingering after purchase or loitering
- When available, packaging of products that we sell contains an additional "do not consume in public" warning

- 3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.
- We maintain contact with neighbors and work with them to create and preserve a positive impact on our community
- Our shop has plenty of on-street parking directly in front of the store and additional parking along the street frontage of the commercial area; customers will not have to park in front of neighbors' residences to visit the store
- We routinely clean up the sidewalk in front of the store as well as the surrounding area, before and after store hours, and spot-check these areas throughout the day as time permits
- We encourage customers not to litter, including by use of custo packaging pre-printed with the message "please, do not litter"
