<p>Everyone is greeted by signage upon entry that states: No Minors allowed in English and Spanish. Our budtenders are trained to card everyone and focus on anyone who looks 30 or under. There is required signage posted at the register warning of the risk of marijuana by minors. Keep it out of reach, Dont Pass it on.</p>

Posted signage warning use in, on or around premises is not allowed, We have trained our budtenders to be on the lookout for any problem customers and will warn them verbally and 86 them if they don't respect the rules.

**3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.**

We have a nice store and pay triple net services for lot cleaning, located next to Plaid Pantry helps us keep a constant presence and an eye out for problems like loitering. Our patrons don't loiter but sometimes we have homeless people who try and bring sleeping bags and try to set up camp in front of us and Plaid Pantry. We ask them nicely to move, then if they won't cooperate we call Portland Police for assistance.

**4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.**

We are very open with the community and have good relations with all businesses. We all work together to promote each other, We have a good neighbor policy and respond to all interactions with positivity and collaboration. We wish to set a good example for Papa Buds and cannabis to uphold its image in the highest regards.

If a complaint comes in ownership addresses it immediately always in a good spirit of resolution. So far its just been praise from the neighborhood, we care greatly about our percieved image with our community, good relations should equal good business.
