1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

Identification is required to enter the licensed premises. The identification is checked before any customer, vendor or contractor is allowed through the secure locked buzzed door. The ID is also scanned through a scanner that verifies the customers age and flashes red if the customer is under 21 years old when needed. The person checking ID's is trained and has access to an ID checking book.

We will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors in three main ways.

First, we will have labeling on all products containing the stating that it should be kept away from minors.

Second, we will make various literature available including the flyers put out by the OLCC on the risks marijuana has to children.

Third, we will sell products in ASTM certified child resistant packaging.

2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.

We will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near our business in three main ways. First, we will post signage reminding customers not to consume cannabis around or near our business. Second, we will install cameras and lights to deter people from using cannabis around our business. Third, we will have conversations with our customers about the importance of not using cannabis around our business and being good neighbors and stewards of the legal cannabis market.

If anyone is found using cannabis around our business we will immediately ask them to stop and will call the Portland Police Department when necessary.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

We will address these issues in several ways:

- Pick up garbage daily around the building
- Have designated parking spots for the business
- Post signage reminding people not to park in spots that are not dedicated to our business if it becomes a problem
- Work with registered neighborhood associations to address any concerns or issues that arise
- Be willing and available to address any issues with the neighborhood and resolve any problems if any should arrive

If any of these issues become a problem we will involve what resources are required to address the issue including: neighbors, neighborhood associations, police, ONI, or others as needed.

4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.

We will immediately engage in communication to identify the problem and find a solution. People can reach our owners and managers 24 hours per day 365 days per year. We strive to be good neighbors and are committed to resolving any problems that may arise professionally and quickly.
