1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

The proposed location at 111121 SE Division St. in Portland, OR is designed to prevent unauthorized entry of any type, especially by minors.

The company and its team have developed visitor protocols per 845-025-1230, which includes the screening of any persons accessing the licensed premises, including employees and contractors. Per the visitor protocol all visitors must provide valid identification which is verified and recorded in the visitor log. This ID verification will allow license representatives to ensure no minors will knowingly be allowed on the premises where marijuana or marijuana items are present.

To ensure no minors, or unauthorized persons, unknowingly access the premises, all restricted areas include ANSI grade 1 or higher locks that will remain locked from the exterior at all times. Only authorized personnel will have key or code access to the restricted area and will be fully trained on the visitor protocols.

The premises will also display the appropriate signage per 845-025-1245.

In addition, the team will utilize proper storage per 845-025-3220, child resistant packaging per 845-025-7020, will only advertise and market in accordance with 845-025-8040 and 845-025-8060.

The company will establish and maintain this controlled environment within and surrounding the licensed premises and having tailored the layout to prevent entrance by minors and unauthorized persons to areas where marijuana and marijuana items are present.

In addition to the above listed protocols posters, flyers and info cards with the poison control centers contact info and marijuana related information will be available for all customers. Finally, all staff members will be trained on the risks of marijuana use by minors to provide information and guidance to customers upon request regarding the risks of marijuana use by minors.

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2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.

The premises will display the appropriate signage per 845-025-1245. In addition, all staff will be trained to inform customers of the laws regarding marijuana use in public. Lastly, if a situation occurs where there is consumption around or near the business, staff will be adequately trained to confront the situation in a peaceful and non-threatening manner.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

The proposed location has operated as a Medical Marijuana Dispensary for several years. The protocols in place to address all potential negative impacts will be continued and a neighborhood outreach will be conducted to identify and address any concerns of the residences and businesses in close proximity.

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4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.

In the event of a complaint, management will first try to discuss the complaint with the neighboring business or residence to determine a solution that will work for all parties. If the neighboring business or residence is unwilling to discuss the complaint or an amicable solution can not be determined between the two parties, management will work with the appropriate governing body to determine the best possible outcome for all parties involved.

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
