

A GUIDE FOR SOCIAL CONSUMPTION OF CANNABIS IN PORTLAND

Buying cannabis in Portland
is EASY.

But figuring out where to enjoy
cannabis with friends can be TOUGH.

Here are some guidelines to make sure
cannabis consumption goes smoothly!

REQUIRED & RECOMMENDED

LOCATION

CANNOT be in area controlled by OLCC-licensed
business (OAR 845-025-8520)

Should be 1,000 feet from schools (recommended)

Should have a designated point of contact (recommended)

Should ensure volunteers do not consume cannabis
(recommended)



CONSUMPTION

CANNOT take place indoors if open to public (ORS 433.502 & 433.845)

Should not be within public view (recommended)

**Should include information encouraging the use of designated
drivers, cabs, ride share services, public transit, or other ways to
attend and leave the event safely** (recommended)

GUESTS

MUST be over 21, or be issued an Oregon
Medical Marijuana registry identification card
(ORS 475B.316 & 475B.797)

MUST bring their own cannabis (cannabis businesses
CANNOT sell or give away cannabis to consumers, except as
allowed by OAR 845-025-2840 & 845-025-2880; and PCC
14B.130.030 & 14B.130.080)
