**1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.**

All individuals attempting to enter the premises will be required to show a valid government-issued identification card. License representatives will be trained to inspect identification to verify validity. To help prevent attempted entry by minors, signage on the outside and inside will clearly state that minors are not allowed on the premises. When individuals enter the premises, they will be in a waiting room, separated from the marijuana sales room by a remote-locked secure door. Only after an individual's identification is checked will a license representative remotely unlock the door and allow individuals to enter the marijuana sales room. Upon every sale a warning card explain the risks of cannabis consumption by minors and will be encouraged to keep their purchase out of the reach of minors as well. In addition, all employees will be 21 years of age or older, and anyone under the age of 21 will not be permitted to work in the premises.

**2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.**

We will continue to monitor our premises and surrounding areas for cannabis consumption and usage. If we notice cannabis being consumed around or near the premises we will politely confront the individual/s that they must consume/use in a private area. If they continue to do so and will not adhere to our request to immediately stop the proper authorities will be notified and the individual/s will not be permitted to enter or purchase cannabis in the future.

**3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.**

Representatives of Tree House Collective will routinely make trips outside to clean up around the building and the bus stop on the corner. We also monitor the 30 minute parking zone and have a good relationship with the parking checkers. We haven't had any issues with loitering or noise thus far but if either pop up a manager will politely address the situation personally on a case by case basis.

**4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.**

As far as issues such as complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses and residents we have not had any yet. We try to be as courteous and mindful of our surroundings as possible. We have a good relationship with them and if anything was to come up a manager or owner would personally handle and address the situation/s on a case by case basis, with a quick response so there wasn't any negative long-term impact. Last, we would circle back and inquire if the issue was properly resolved or if there was something that was missed or could be improved on.
