1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

All staff members are required to take an ID checking class offered by the OLCC. IDs are checked twice prior to a sale, and we keep an ID guide book on hand. All products feature labels indicating they contain THC and to keep away from minors. Posters are displayed educating customers on keeping cannabis out of the hands of minors, and products leave the store in ASTM certified child proof packaging.

2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.

Signage at the entrance and exit to the store advises customers that no consumption is allowed on the property. Further, exterior cameras and lighting deter use on or near the site. We also educated and discuss this topic with our customers, in addition to walking the parking lot to discourage any loitering or use on the property. If anyone is found using cannabis around our business we will immediately ask them stop and will call the Portland Police Department when necessary.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

We address these issues in several ways:

- We routinely pick up garbage around our place of business
- We have designated parking spots for our business
- Post signage reminding customers to respect our neighbors
- Work with registered business and neighborhood associations when warranted or needed
- Are available to discuss issues with our neighbors to try to work as a team
- Work with our neighbors, local associations, ONI, City of Portland, and the police to resolve any issues at or around our place of business
