Application for the above has been reviewed by the Noise Control Officer, City of Portland, and is hereby:

Approved, with the following conditions:

- A. Applicant is to notify all neighbors within a one and half block radius of the event.
- B. Speakers to face away from closest residence.
- C. Sound levels will not be audible further than one block from the source of the sound up to 11:00 p.m. The decibel level will therefore not exceed 70 dBA, with occasional peaks to 73 dBA (FAST) at any unaffiliated receiver up to 11:00 p.m. The Applicant or a representative shall monitor and reduce level to meet the above standards.
- D. Live music will cease at 1:00 a.m. SHARP on Sunday, July 21, 2019, and at 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 21, 2019, or by 10:15 p.m. if schedule is running behind.
- E. Sound levels will be reduced upon receipt of any complaints.
- F. Applicant will notify management of Portland Marriott Downtown Waterfront Hotel at 1401 SW Naito Parkway and of Kimpton RiverPlace Hotel at 1510 SW Harbor Way about event and ending times. Applicant will supply the two hotels with a phone number to call to reach a live person with noise concerns during the event.
- G. Applicant will report any complaints they receive to the Noise Office at (503) 823-7350.
- H. Permit is revocable by both the Portland Police Bureau or the Noise Office. A copy is to be supplied to the local Precinct for the Night Sergeants.

To the Applicant:

1. Carry this document with you during the activity. This is not a permit to make more noise than is minimally necessary for your needs.
2. Violation of the conditions of this variance constitutes grounds for revocation of the variance, and denial of future applications, and may also result in the issuance of citation(s) for violations of City Code.
3. If a Police or Noise Control Officer should appear, his/her instructions will supersede this variance and take precedence.
