What is CPOT?

- **Type III Public advisory body**
- **Industry representatives and others that possess an in-depth understanding of issues affecting and affected by cannabis**

Objective: To discuss and provide input in development of policies that support equitable access and outcomes for the cannabis industry, cannabis consumers, and all City of Portland residents.



CPOT's Role

- Inform:** Provide review of and feedback on policies and procedures
- Monitor:** Check on progress of a previous decision or program activities
- Forecast:** Provide input and information to the program about emerging community needs and marketplace trends
- Preliminary Advising:** Generate annual reports to the program and Civic Life Bureau Director

City Cannabis License Requirements

AT APPLICATION SUBMITTAL

- Application form
- Personal History forms
- Zoning Verification
- Land Use Compatibility Statement (LUCS)
- Marijuana Control Plan (Retailers)
- Security Plan
- Floor plan or site plan (if not constructed)

BY LICENSE ISSUANCE

- Security Alarm Permit
- Electrical Permits (for security system, unless wireless)
- Documentation of security system (30 days backup)
- Property ownership or lease
- City Business License Certificate of Compliance
- Secretary of State Registry
- Commercial Building Permits and other permits (Producers and Processors ONLY)

State Cannabis License Requirements

- Application form
- Personal History forms
- Background check / fingerprints
- Completed Land Use Compatibility Statement (LUCS)
- Security Plan
- Floor plan or site plan (if not constructed)
- Questionnaire or LLC, Corporation, Limited Partnership, or sole proprietorship
- Documentation of security system
- Proof of property ownership or lease
- Secretary of State Registry
- Proof of building permitting (Extract Processors ONLY)
- Complete Metrc test
- Operations and security plan
- Commercial-grade locks
- Vaults (as defined by OLCC)
- Specific requirements of cameras and recording on premises
- Minor control plan
- ...other requirements

Legal Status

- **Controlled Substances Act – Schedule I designation**
 - **Impacts every aspect (i.e. citizenship, federal funding, etc)**
- **Measure 91, opt out, and Home Rule**
- **ORS 475B – Cannabis Regulation**
- **Portland City Code Title 14 – Public Order and Police**
- **Portland City Code 14B.130 – Marijuana Regulatory License Procedure and Requirements**



Employment

- **Controlled Substances Act – Schedule I designation**
 - **Risk to employers and employees, employment support agencies**
- **Fair Labor Standards Act**
- **Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries**
 - **No limits to use of independent contractors in cannabis**
- **In Committee- HB 2655 and SB 379 (protection for off-clock use)**
- **ORS 475B**



Taxes & Banking

- **Controlled Substances Act – Schedule I designation**
- **Currency and Foreign Transactions Reporting Act**
- **Federal taxes on gross income**
- **IRS Code Section 280E – prevents deductions**
- **ORS 475B.705 – 17% State tax on retail sales**
- **PCC 6.07 – 3% City tax on retail sales**



Land Use & Housing

- **Controlled Substances Act – Schedule I designation**
 - **Risks to lenders, insurers, property owners, renters, employees, public housing programs**
- **ORS 475B**
 - **Separates Rec and Med and liquor, 1000' from schools, limits to zoning**
- **PCC 14B.130 / building permits / zoning**
 - **1000' from other retailers/couriers and from schools, not in R zoned, required permits for licensing**



Environment

- **Controlled Substances Act – Schedule I designation**
 - **Limits research, reinforces stigmatization**
- **EPA, OSHA**
 - **Limited guidance and/or programs specific to cannabis (pesticides, approved use, safety, etc)**
- **Oregon Indoor Clean Air Act**
- **State and City regulations for energy, water, waste and odor**



Health

- **Controlled Substances Act – Schedule I designation**
 - **Limits research, advertising, prescribing, VA restrictions**
- **Federal Agencies- EPA, FDA**
 - **Limited guidance and/or programs specific to cannabis (contaminants, approved use, dosing, food safety, etc)**
- **ORS 475B & OAR 333**
 - **Rec / Med use, defines conditions, prescribers, fees, potency**



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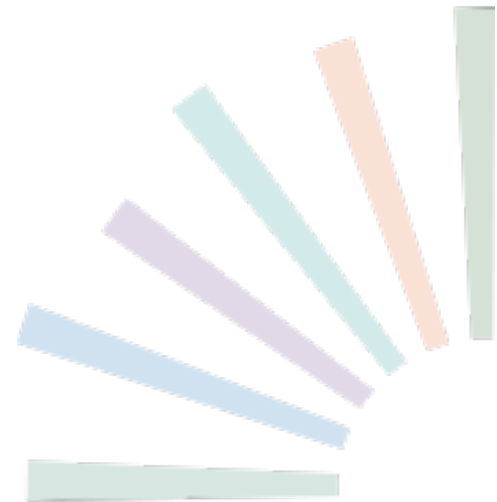
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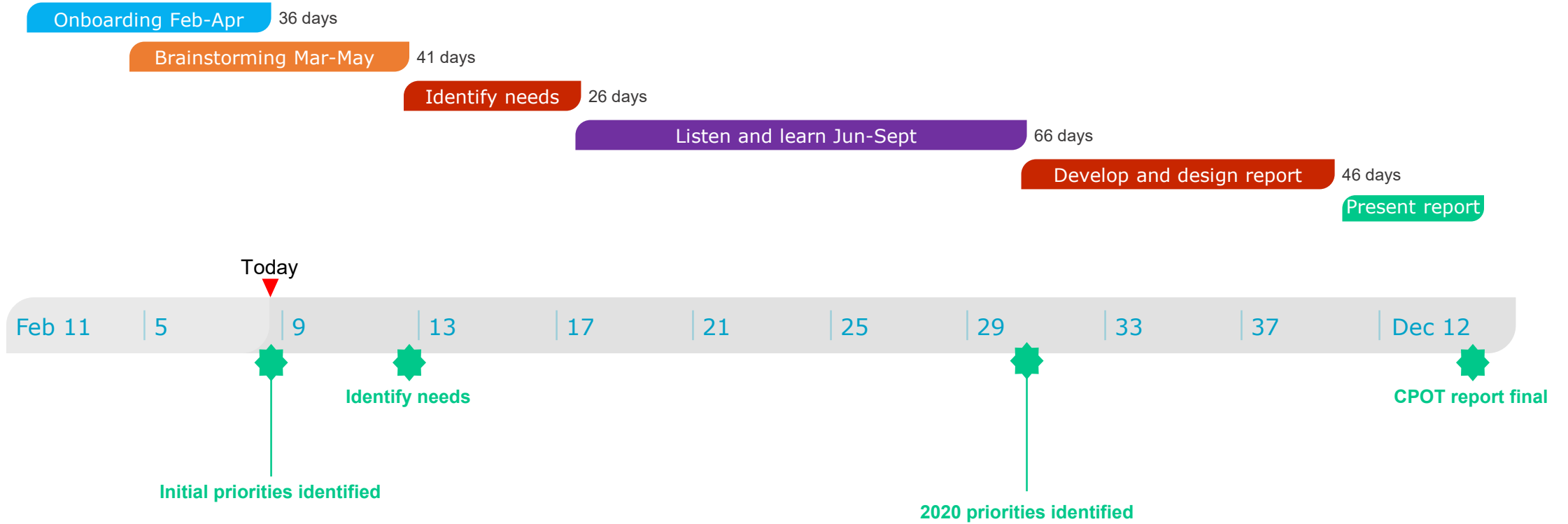

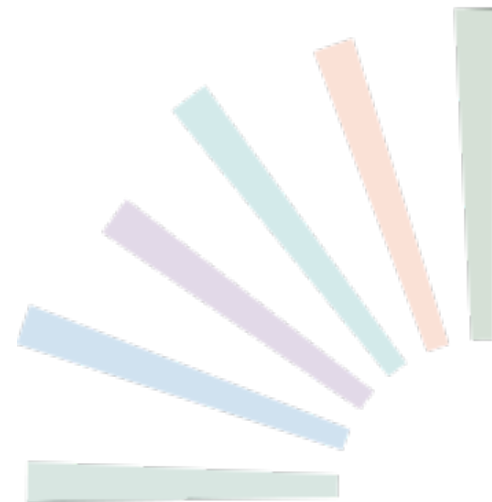
