1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

All visitors are stopped in the lobby and asked for valid ID. If they cannot prove that they are over 21, or 18 with a valid OMMP patient registration, they will be asked to leave. Only upon presenting valid ID will an individual be admitted to the sales floor.

All required signage will be posted throughout the facility to assist educating customers on the risks of marijuana use by minors. In addition, facility staff will be available to answer customer questions.

2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.

Required signage will be placed throughout the facility informing customers that it is illegal to consume cannabis products on-site. Staff are trained to detect when an individual may be attempting to consume a cannabis product and will ask any customer suspected of doing so to leave. Staff will regularly monitor the exterior of the premises, through both surveillance monitoring and physical rounds, to ensure that no individuals are consuming cannabis products in or around the premises.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

We strive to maintain a neat and orderly appearance and business and will keep the area clean and tidy to help prevent livability issues. There is plenty of off-street parking available for customers so that the business will not cause parking issues. Staff will monitor the premises and immediately surrounding area for garbage and debris, and will alert management or law enforcement as appropriate if any individuals are discovered loitering or causing a disturbance.
