Implement community risk reduction program

- Create a transition & implementation plan to integrate inspectors into our communities & stations
- Develop a menu of education & incentive programs for FMAs to offer to homeowners & businesses for prevention

Implement new innovations in fire preventionInnovations

- Integrate new software solution that streamlines code inspection process & brings Company Fire Inspection Program (CFIP) back into Prevention
- Implement a tracking program for inspection, testing, & maintenance of fire protection systems
- Issue conditional use permits online
- Implement apps for public safety messages

Implement mobile capabilities for Fire Inspectors

- Implement mobile data entry solution for use during inspections
- Complete required training to use mobile apps
- Implement mobile access for obtaining pertinent building information in the field

Code Enforcement

- Complete 100% of high-priority inspections within 27 months
- Complete 90% of fire inspection data entry within 2 business days
- Complete 100% of re-inspections within 90 days
- Complete 100% of referral responses within 2 weeks
- Complete 100% of CFIP logs within 1 month
- Complete 90% of Senior/Accounting logs within 3 business days
- Resend 90% of returned invoices & letters within 1 week

Plan Review

- Review 90% of all plans requiring fire approval per established turnaround goals
- Process pre-issuance of permits within 1 business day

Investigations

- Complete 90% of all required reports within 2 weeks of the incident's occurrence
- Develop real time tracking to identify fire problems & possible arson activity
- Research past fire deaths & injuries & analyze contributing factors
- Develop a training program that will assist company officers with the basic procedures involved in an origin & cause investigation & accurate fire report writing
