Additional State Tax Offset Benefit

The statement you initial above may affect your pension benefits:

- If you are NOT currently receiving additional tax offset benefits and you check the first option, that your pension benefits WILL be subject to Oregon personal income tax, then you will begin receiving additional tax offset benefits effective January 1 if you are otherwise eligible for the benefit.
- If you ARE currently receiving additional tax offset benefits and you check the second option, that your pension benefits WILL NOT be subject to Oregon personal income tax, then you will cease receiving additional tax offset benefits effective January 1.

Per Oregon state law, you may be eligible for an additional state tax offset benefit if you are subject to Oregon personal income tax, either at the time of your retirement or at some later date. Under the law, you are required to promptly notify FPDR by written statement if your pension payments are no longer subject to Oregon personal income tax or are once again subject to Oregon personal income tax.

If you are required to file an Oregon personal income tax return for the year after the year in which you submitted this form and your pension payments are subject to Oregon personal income tax, you are eligible for the additional tax offset benefit. Otherwise, you are ineligible. If you have any questions about your eligibility, please consult your tax advisor.
