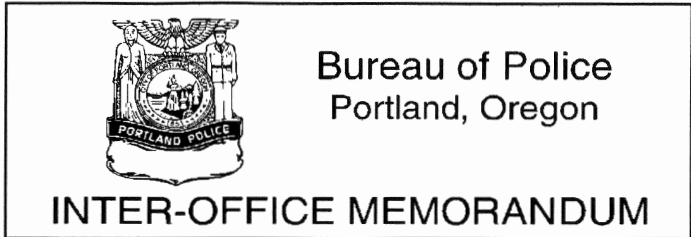

Allegation #1: *Portland Police Bureau Assistant Chief Michael Crebs failed to take appropriate action after being informed that Portland Police Bureau Chief Lawrence O'Dea was involved in an off-duty negligent discharge of a firearm, which resulted in injury. (CONDUCT)*

Recommended Findings: **Unfounded – 2, Exonerated – 2**
