**Director's Report**

**1. Independent Police Review (IPR) Work Plan / Accomplishments**

**OIR Group Report on Officer-Involved Shootings**

The OIR Group released its sixth report on Portland Police officer-involved shootings. The report covers nine incidents that took place between 2014 and 2017. The OIR Group identified several themes that warrant further attention by Police Bureau command staff and made 40 recommendations for future incidents. **Community Outreach**

IPR Senior Community Outreach Coordinator Irene Konev attended, networked and recruited volunteers to serve on the Police Review Board at the 2019 Black History Month Proclamation and Community Reception, Commissioner Hardesty's Swearing-in After Party, Fix-it Fair held at Ockley Green Middle School and at Elders in Action monthly volunteer meeting. She attended the Hate in Public Spaces meeting comprised of City staff working with community-based organizations of Portland United Against Hate.

She coordinated a community meeting to hear from the Office of Independent Review who published their sixth report on nine officer-involved shootings.

Konev led the efforts to coordinate the second annual Slavic and Eastern European Celebration Week Proclamation. She also participated in the coordination of the Slavic & Eastern European Heritage Celebration and Open House at Immigrant Refugee Community Organization.
