## Independent Police Review Announces Recruitment for Volunteers to Serve on the Citizen Review Committee

The [Independent Police Review](#) (IPR) is recruiting volunteers to serve three-year terms on the [Citizen Review Committee](#) (CRC).

The CRC is an advisory body to IPR and the [Portland Police Bureau](#). CRC members hear community and Police Bureau member appeals of police misconduct investigations, listen to public concerns regarding police conduct, engage in training and other activities to learn about policing, review Police Bureau policies and procedure. CRC members also advise IPR by participating in the development of policy recommendations of, review methods for handling complaints, and advise the IPR Director on the criteria for dismissal, mediation and investigation.

- There are **several** volunteer positions commencing in December 2019.
- Applicants must be Portland, Oregon residents or business owners.
- These volunteer positions will include service on the Police Review Board to make fact-based recommendations for discipline in use of force incidents to the Chief of Police and Police Commissioner.
