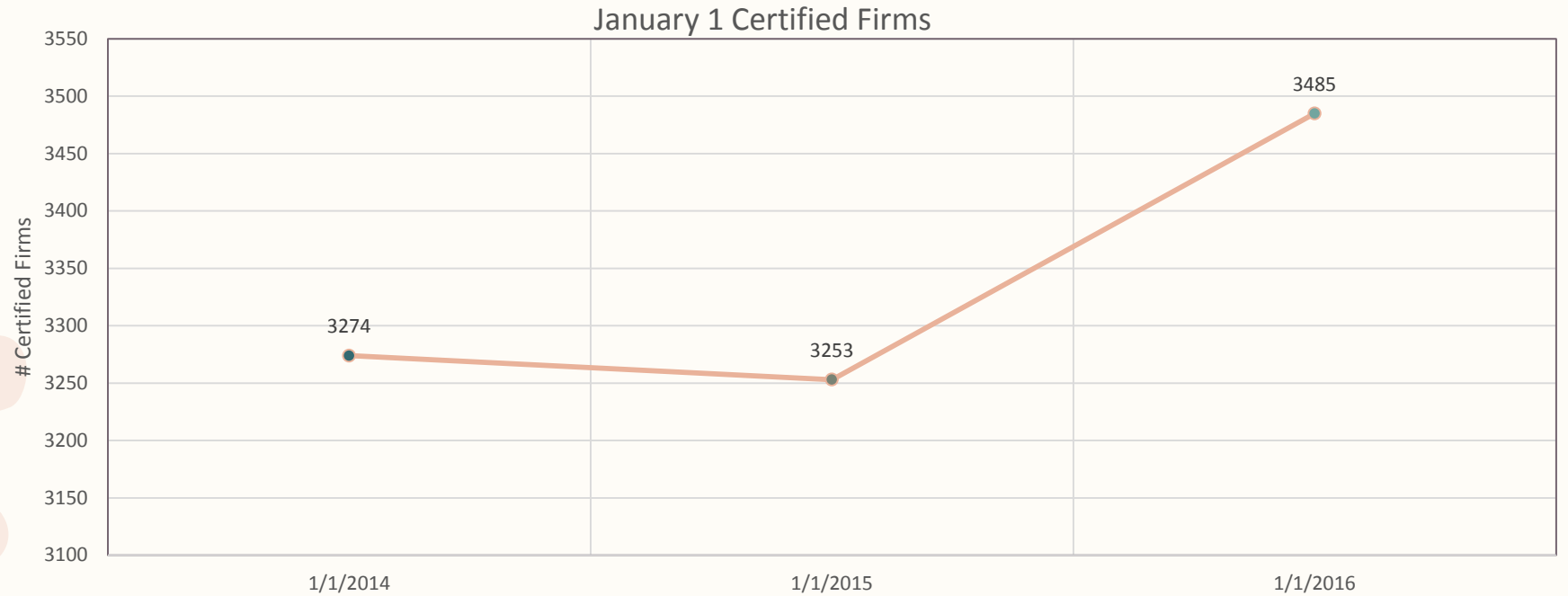

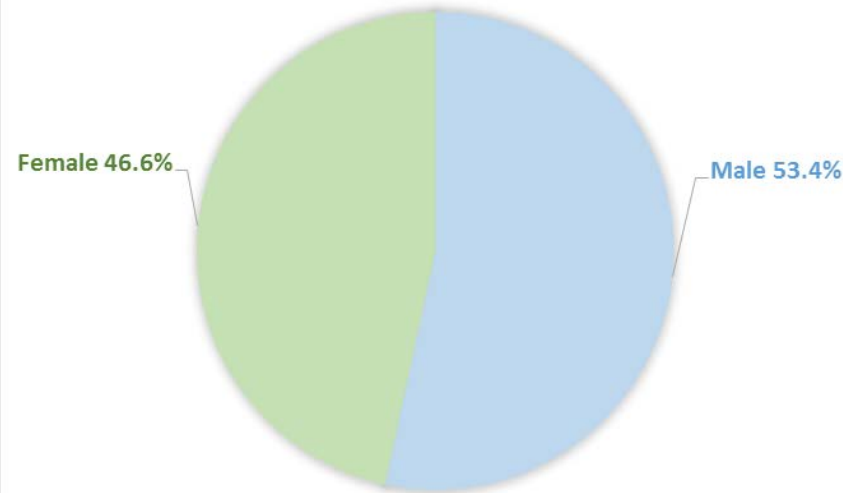

New Firms – Gender Breakdown

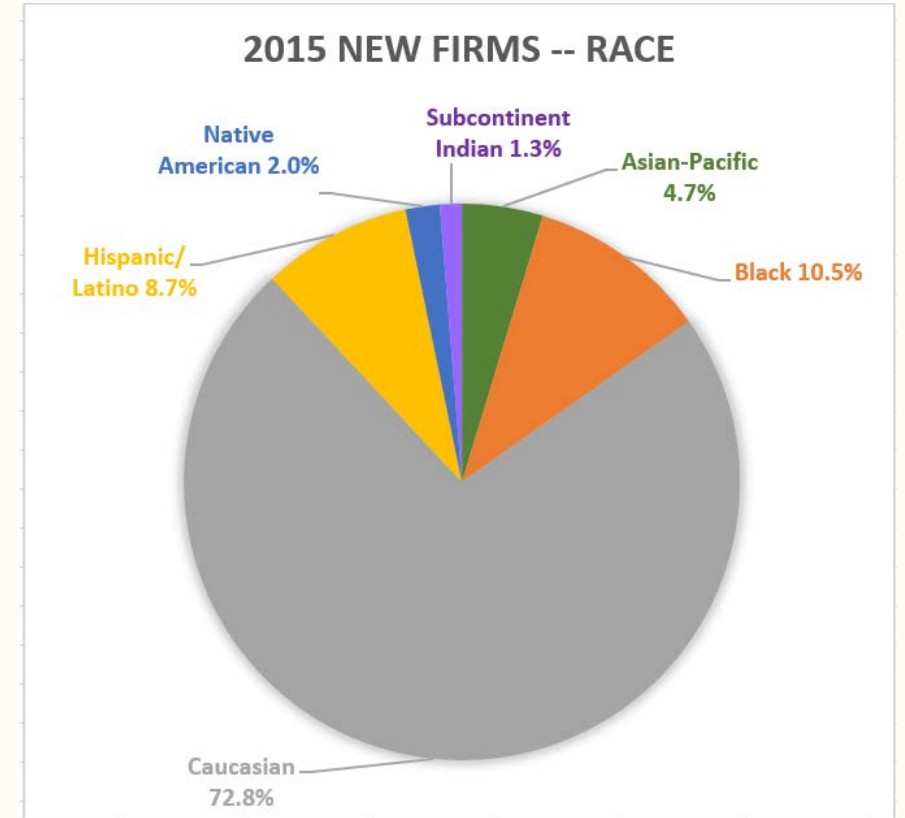
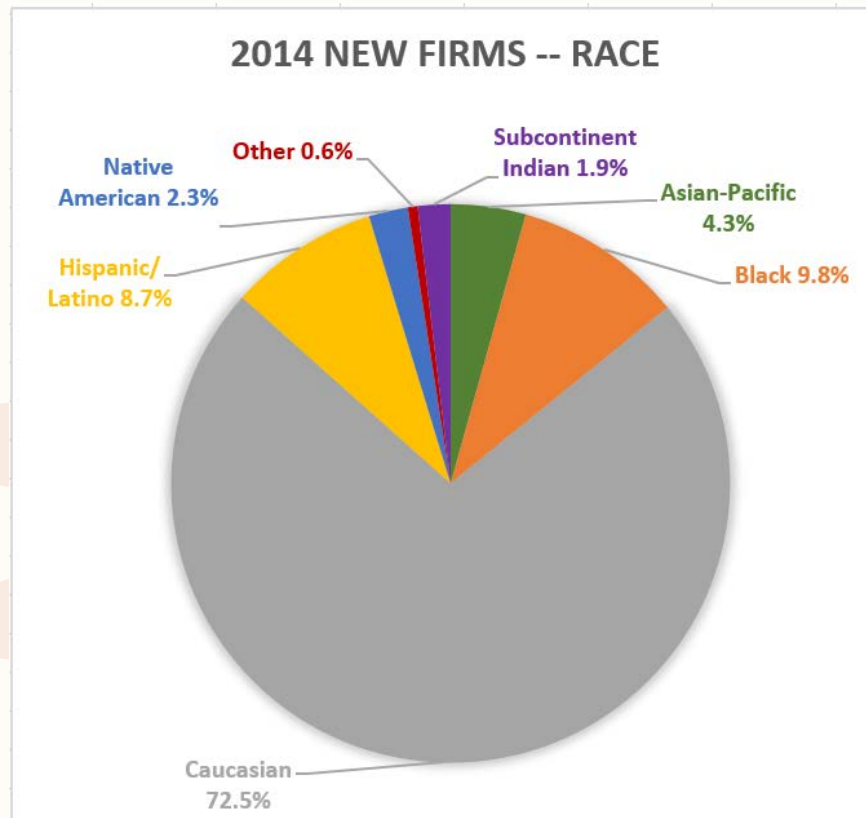
2014 NEW FIRMS -- GENDER



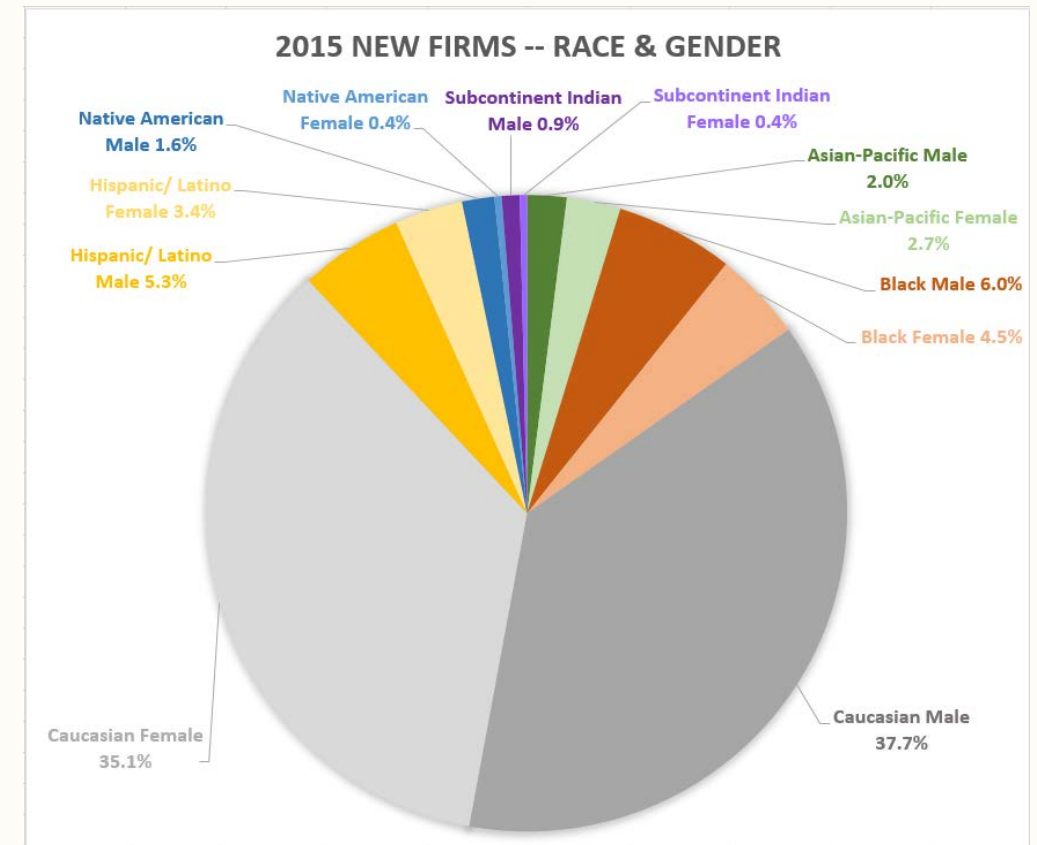
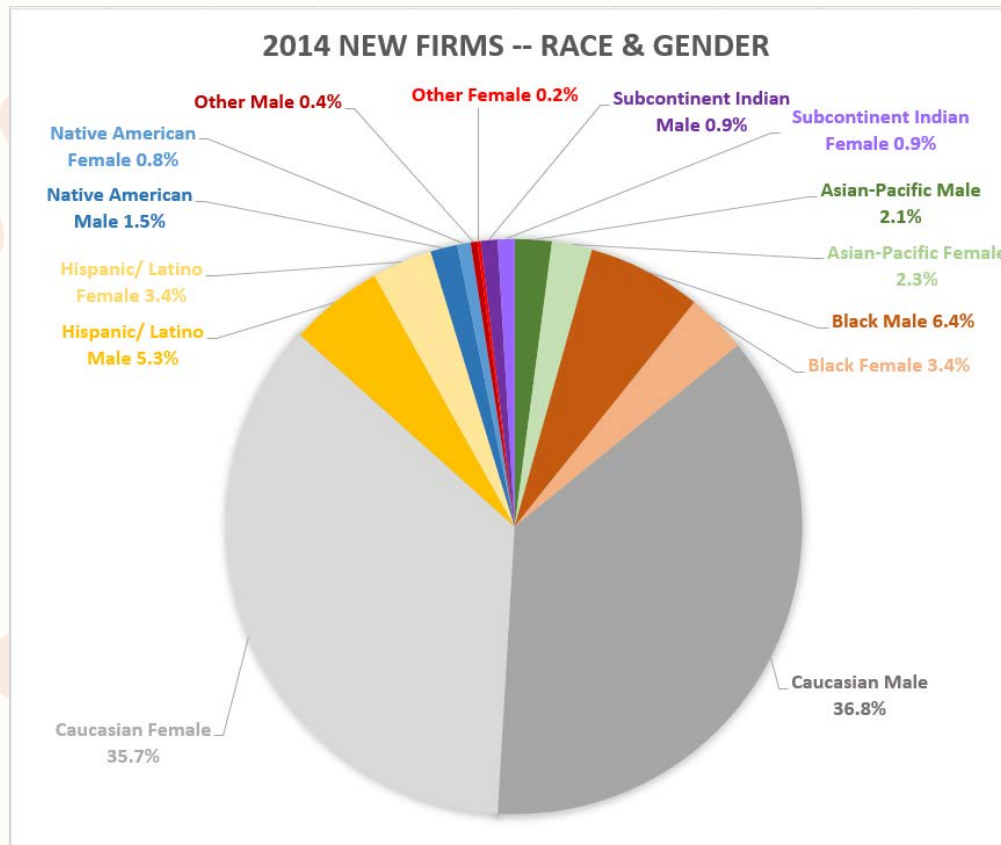
2015 NEW FIRMS -- GENDER
