Discussion:

- The committee shared updates from other OMF labor management groups.
- More than 300,000 Arts Tax notification mailers will be sent out to Portland residents in the coming weeks. Mailers will include a PBOT flyer which highlights the City's new 20 MPH speed limit within residential areas.
