### **Discussion:**

- Kristin Wells gave an overview of the progress made on the Portland Building Reconstruction project.
  - o Project is ahead of schedule and under budget.
  - Work groups are focusing on individual work spaces.
  - Space optimization plans will be scalable to other buildings and bureaus.
- The committee shared updates from other OMF LMCs.
  - New internal processes in the Revenue Division are working well and tax collection is at a record high.
  - EBS continues to explore cloud-based solutions.
  - CityFleet has been focusing on workplace safety and will take part in a safety conference on October 25.
  - o The new Facilities work order system has been updated and is working well.
  - BTS is holding classes on a "Listen First" program for customer service and will hold its annual picnic on September 13.
- Tom Rinehart gave an update on a budget process change.
  - Recommendations will be presented to the Mayor.
  - Once the Mayor has reviewed the recommendations they will be sent to bureau directors.
