The Portland Building Reconstruction project offers a unique opportunity to invest in community opportunities and enhancements. The Office of Management and Finance (OMF) has set aside one percent of the project's hard construction costs to support community opportunities and enhancements. Originally scheduled to be heard before Council on May 11, the Mayor's Office, OMF, and the Office of Equity and Human Rights have decided to postpone City Council's consideration of this plan to allow additional time for community involvement.

The Equitable Contracting and Purchasing Commission (ECPC) will be discussing the plan at their May 19 meeting. Members of the community are invited to listen to the discussion and participate in public comment on the plan.
