Travel Portland, the official destination marketing organization for the City of Portland, along with Wieden+Kennedy, created the largest free-standing cuckoo clock in America for the 2014 "Portland is Happening Now" campaign. The 24-foot tall cuckoo clock was handmade in Oregon and was assembled in Portland by designers Nicolas Gros and J. Chester Armstrong.
