

## COVID - Other Local Services

**OMSI** closed on November 13 after Governor issued “freeze” order. Had been reopened on a limited basis prior to that - Mon-Sun 10am-7pm, reserve tickets <https://omsi.edu/COVID-19>

**Oregon Historical Society** closed since November 13<sup>th</sup> due to Governor’s “freeze” order. It had reopened 7/11with limitations.

**Portland Art Museum** closed since December 4, 2020 - The Museum and NW Film Center are currently closed in accordance with orders from Governor Kate Brown. They had reopened 7/16 with limitations.

**Portland International Airport** announced new physical distancing rules effective May 18, including a requirement that everyone at the airport wear face coverings.

### **Portland Public Schools (PPS)**

Schooling Fall 2020 will be online until at least February 2021. On December 23, 2020 the Governor announced schools would be allowed to open to in-person learning January 1, 2021 but that it would up to individual districts to determine when to reopen. Governor hopes more schools resume on-site teaching by February 15th.
