Updates from OMF LMCs

CityFleet (Eric Chitoubol)

CityFleet had its LMC meeting on October 5 and has taken down the boards at its 1st and Jefferson facility.

A parts shortage and a slowdown for deliveries has made Fleet's operations more time consuming, and this slowdown is exacerbated by the fact that Fleet is already understaffed considering its workload.

There are nine vacancies that need to be filled, and a skills test is being developed for the candidates selected for those vacancies. That said, several current technicians have been put through certification training.

BTS/P&D (Paul Cone)

BTS has had a quiet month and talked about safety at its last LMC meeting. The Police IT Manager is following up with BTS about its signage, which is installed by facilities.

There has been one retirement, retirement. The Support Center is temporarily reporting to Brian Pirrello and will be until a more permanent manager is selected by Jeff Baer.

Facilities (Theo Leiatua)

Facilities has satisfied its safety training requirement by holding classes individually.

There is a specialist position opening, and there have been some in-person and online classes to satisfy Facilities' safety training requirement. They have nothing else to report.

Revenue (Iana Spada)

Revenue has been doing a lot of hiring since the last meeting, from taxation specialists to auditors and managers. Revenue is up and their work looks good. They have nothing else to report.
