Polo's family was expelled from Indonesia, granted asylum in Netherlands, then resettled in Oregon. He's a West Coast and southeast Asia activist-lawyer; a fellow of the International Court of Justice in The Hague.

He is also contributing editor at *The Asian Reporter*, and a commentator on Wisconsin, Milwaukee, and Oregon Public Radio. He authored *Counter Culture: Immigrant Stories from Portland Café Counters*.

Polo manages the City of Portland's New Portlander Programs. In his role, he works with community partners to promote equity and inclusion within Portland and throughout the region, producing measurable improvements and disparity reductions. He works to resolve issues rooted in bias and discrimination, through research, education, and service.
