II. Review a request from Wayne Stalter of the Oregon Department of Transportation for night time roadway construction work on 82 <sup>nd</sup> Avenue from SE Division to NE Couch Street, in specific intersections including SE Division Street; SE Mill Street; SE Washington; SE Stark; SE Yamhill; East Burnside; SE Duke and NE Sandy Blvd. Work within each intersection ranges from a few nights up to a request of 24 nights at NE Sandy. These nights of work are proposed to occur between September 1, 2015 and August 31, 2016	Review, Deny, Modify or Delegate to Noise Control Officer
III. Review a request from Dave Sweeney, representing Sportscar Vintage Racing Association (SVRA) for a race at the Portland Parks enterprise-zone type property known as Portland International Raceway (PIR). The request is for a three year , multi-year variance to hold for one weekend of racing each year ( 2015 to 2017) The variance , if approved would use up one of four annual race variances available in Portland to operate at the highest decibel limit of 115 dBA (FAST) as measured at 50 feet from the racing vehicles. Request for a construction noise variance from Joey Bowles of Walsh Construction for 5 extended work dates, with potential work hours from 5 AM to 6 PM, for work located at 1616 NW 13 <sup>th</sup> Avenues, between NW Raleigh and NW Savier. The 5 requested dates would occur between February 12th, 2015 and April 30, 2015. The work is described as 5 large volume concrete deck pours.
