**1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.**

Pure Green will post all required signage relating to the exclusion of minors from the premises.

Pure Green will always have an employee at the front desk, immediately adjacent to the front door (the only public entrance into Pure Green). That employee will be instructed to verify the age of anyone who enters. Pure Green will provide all employees with adequate instructions in age verification.

Anyone who is under 21 years of age or who cannot officially verify that they are 21 years of age or older will be asked to leave immediately. If they refuse to leave in a timely manner, Pure Green staff may call authorities or, in an emergency, push one of the panic buttons.

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**2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.**

The Pure Green camera surveillance system covers much of the area immediately surrounding Pure Green. The Pure Green staff regularly monitors the camera feed.

If they observe anyone consuming cannabis products in the immediate vicinity of the licensed premises, they will inform that person that they are not legally permitted to consume cannabis in public and ask them to move along. If they refuse, the Pure Green staff will alert authorities.

Pure Green will post all required signage and information regarding the laws and rules governing public cannabis consumption in Oregon. The Pure Green staff will be trained and educated about those laws and rules and will be able to impart this information to all customers.

**3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.**

Pure Green has been operating for almost four years at the same location. During that time, we have not received a single complaint from any neighbor regarding noise, parking, garbage or any other neighborhood livability issue.

We have six dedicated parking spaces along the side of our building, along with several short term, on-street parking spaces.

Pure Green does not generate a great deal of noise. In addition, our building is made of concrete and sealed tightly so little noise escapes. Patrons are not permitted to loiter outside so outdoor noise has never been a problem. As noted above, Pure Green staff continuously watches the security monitors. Anyone loitering outside, whether they are making noise or not, will be asked to move along.

Pure Green has regularly scheduled garbage and recycling collection. Garbage containers are kept locked at all times. Pure Green staff regularly checks the exterior of the premises for trash and picks up any litter that accumulates.

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**4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.**

Pure Gren takes extremely seriously its responsibility to be a good neighbor. We are actively engaged in our community in a number of ways from attending the Hollywood Veteran's Day parade to sponsoring a team in the Susan G Komen walk.

Any complaints from neighboring businesses or residents will be immediately referred to Pure Green owners Matt and Meghan Walstatter. Matt and Meghan will talk to the individual or a representative of the business who made the complaint. They will formulate and implement a plan of remediation.

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
