1. Please describe your plan to prevent theft at the licensed premises, including robberies, burglaries, and shoplifting.

We plan to prevent robbery, theft, burglary, and shoplifting through a combination of employee training, surveillance, store set-up, and operating procedures.

The threat of robbery is prevented in several ways. Advanced security camera systems in plain sight serve as a deterrent against robbery, as any assailants would be captured on video at several stages. Outdoor cameras can easily identify specific descriptive traits of any vehicle on the premises including make, model, color and license plate number. A bulletproof security window protects employees from the threat of armed robbery, and fortified doors prevent forced entry to the sales floor. In the event of a robbery, the store is equipped with two silent alarm panic buttons easily accessible to staff.

Burglaries are prevented through a combination of surveillance, fortification, and other deterrents. The outside premises of the facility are well lit, making any attempted burglary highly visible from 82nd Avenue and the surrounding businesses and neighborhood. Motion sensitive lights further serve to attract attention to any foul play at night. In addition, the facility is equipped with fortified security locks and doors. We are in the process of installing security bars on all ground level windows. In the event of any attempted forced entry, our alarm system, provided by Cannaguard, will notify management and the authorities immediately.

Shoplifting by staff or customers is prevented through the use of visible surveillance cameras as a deterrent. Our procedure allows for only one customer per employee at the point of sale. Customers are asked to be seated on the back wall away from the point of sale while waiting, to minimize the opportunity for theft. All product is secured in glass cases when not in use. Additionally, managers can supervise customers and staff through the two-way window located behind the point of sale area. Finally, all inventory is tracked to the 1/100th of a gram by our point of sale system, and employees are monitored for significant inventory shortfalls.
