1. Please describe your plan to prevent theft at the licensed premises, including robberies, burglaries, and shoplifting.

We have the following equipment and procedures in place to prevent theft, robberies, burglaries and shoplifting.

We use commercial grade doors on all required doors.

We ensure that all consumer entrances and exits are securely locked during hours when we are not operating and keys possessed only by authorized individuals.

We have an alarm system that complies with OAR 845-025-1420. This system covers all required points of entry and exit and windows, is capable of detecting movement, includes two panic buttons and is programmed to notify Security Monster and/or law enforcement of any breach or use of a panic button.

We have a video surveillance system that complies with OAR 845-025-1430 through OAR 845-025-1460. This system covers all ingress and egress points, points of sale and limited access areas.

All employees receive training on theft prevention as well as procedures to take if we were burglarized or robbed. Panic buttons are readily available in case of an emergency.

We ensure sufficient staffing during operations to ensure consumers are carefully watched and assisted to prevent shoplifting. Our products are kept in employee-only access areas and require the assistance from an employee to look at and/or smell.

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2. Please describe your plan to control access to your establishment and ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted.

We prevent minors from entering the licensed premises, obtaining marijuana items or attempting to obtain marijuana items as required by OAR 845-025-1230(6)(a) and OAR 845-025-8520.

We check all consumer identification to verify that a person is at least 21 years of age prior to access being granted through a locked door that requires access to be granted by employees only.

We post signage at all ingress and egress points on the premises and point of sale that read "No Minors Allowed" and "Restricted Access Area - No Minors Allowed".

We additionally require all employees, before a sale is made, to check a customer's identification to verify that the consumer is at least 21 years of age.

3. In order to reduce the possibility of underage persons, as established by law, from gaining access to marijuana products sold at the licensed premises, please describe your plan to educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

All patients and customers receive a 3x5 card with information to educate them on the safe storage (out of reach of children, in a locked area) of marijuana as well as information regarding not using marijuana when minors are around, not using marijuana during pregnancy or breastfeeding as well as the phone number for the Poison Control Center.

All usable marijuana product is provided to consumers in child-resistant safety packaging in accordance with packaging requirements outlined in OAR 333-008-1225 and labeled in accordance with OAR 333-008-1220.

We also have large posters that are clearly visible and easy to read educating the consumers further on the risks of marijuana use by minors in accordance with OAR 333-008-1205.

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4. Please describe your plan to ensure that marijuana products sold by your business are not consumed irresponsibly in public or in the immediate vicinity of the license premises.

We provide 3x5 cards to consumers regarding safe consumption of marijuana products.

We post signage that prohibits the consumption of marijuana products in or near the facility.

Our employees are trained to refuse service to any consumer that appears to be under the influence of any altering substance.

5. Please describe your plan to avoid potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking or garbage from your patrons.

We strive to have open lines of communication with all of our local neighbors and businesses.

Our employees clean-up garbage and the parking lot daily.

We also do not encourage or tolerate disruptive behavior from our patrons. Such behavior would result in refusal of service.

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6. Please describe the process to respond to complaints from neighboring businesses and residents regarding the licensed premises.

We strive to have an open relationship with our customers and neighbors.

Employees are required to immediately notify the owner and discuss any concerns or complaints. Within 24 hours of lodging a concern or complaint, the concerned party will be contacted to discuss the matter and attempt to resolve the issue.

Our goal first and foremost is to be a contributing member to the community and provide a positive, quality image of our business.
