1. Please describe how your business will ensure that no one under the age of 21 is admitted, and how your business will educate patrons on the risks of marijuana use by minors.

We require identification prior to entering the retail floor and check ID again upon purchase of cannabis. Anyone who does not have an ID or is under 21 without a medical marijuana card will be refused access. Any person under 18 will be refused access. If an employee checking ID has any reason to believe the ID of a customer is invalid, the customer will be refused service and asked to leave the premises. Employees will be checked prior to hire and no person will be employed who is not 21 and does not have a valid marijuana workers permit. If a minor attempts to gain access to the premises, they will be immediately told to leave and if they do not, law enforcement will be contacted. We have literature regarding the risks of marijuana use by minors and can discuss with patrons who are unclear of the risks.

2. Please describe how your business will prevent cannabis products from being consumed around or near your business.

If we observe cannabis being consumed on or around our business, we inform the consumer that it is illegal to consume cannabis in public places. If they refuse to comply, we give a direct warning to the user to vacate the premises or law enforcement will be contacted.

3. Please describe how your business will prevent and address potential negative impacts to neighborhood livability such as noise, parking, garbage, or loitering from your patrons.

We have a back parking lot with open spaces to avoid clogging the neighborhood streets. That lot also has garbage receptacles with closed tops to avoid any carryover of odors. There is no loitering allowed on the premises and if discovered, the person/s will be asked to leave. If they do not leave, we will notify them that we are contacting law enforcement to escort them away.

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4. Please briefly describe your business's process to respond to and resolve complaints and/or concerns from neighboring businesses or residences.

If our company receives a complaint/concern, we will reach out directly to try and resolve the matter. If the requests are unreasonable we will try to discuss/create a more realistic solution. If all else fails, we will contact the proper authority to rectify the situation.

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
