Application for the above has been reviewed by the Noise Control Officer, City of Portland, and is hereby:

**Approved, with the following conditions:**

- A. Music will start at 10:00 a.m. (Sound check between 10:00 a.m. and 10:45 a.m.) Music will end at 10:00 p.m.
- B. There are no grace periods on start or end times.
- C. In terms of collecting noise data for the Noise Office and the Noise Review Board: The applicant or a representative will be required to measure the following parameters and work to save the files once per act: Four to five minute measurement periods will be used for compliance. Capture the following noise descriptors, a four or five minute second by second Lmax measurement, and Leq measurement
- D. Sound levels after 12:00 p.m. (noon) and up to 8:00 p.m. may not exceed 70 dBA, with peaks to 75dBA. These measurements are based on an instantaneous one second maximum measurement. Sound will be measured with an A meter and a FAST meter response.
- E. Sound levels before 12:00 p.m. (noon) and after 8:00 p.m. may not exceed 65 dBA, with peaks to 70dBA. These measurements are based on an instantaneous one second maximum measurement. Sound will be measured with an A meter and a FAST meter response.
- F. You should use a protocol of recording the data on a spreadsheet on an hourly basis so as not to lose an entire day's worth of data.


- G. Measurements shall be taken on the Westside curb of Naito. Make sure to make notes of the general period of time when the traffic was an influence. There will be periods of time where traffic is not an impact along Naito. Please make sure to have the meter operator keep good notes.
- H. Applicant must contact the River Place and the Marriott Hotels and supply a contact phone number for the duration of the event. The phone is to be staffed by a live person who can take action at all times.
- I. The written records of the sound level measurements will be supplied to the Noise Control Office within 1 week, 7 calendar days, following the event. Readings will also be made available upon request of the Noise Office during the event.

**To the Applicant:**

- 1. Carry this document with you during the activity. This is not a permit to make more noise than is minimally necessary for your needs.
- 2. Violation of the conditions of this variance constitutes grounds for revocation of the variance, and denial of future applications, and may also result in the issuance of citation(s) for violations of City Code.
- 3. **If a Police or Noise Control Officer should appear, his/her instructions will supersede this variance and take precedence.**
