Application for the above has been reviewed by the Noise Control Officer, City of Portland, and is hereby:

Approved, with the following conditions:


- Speakers are to face away from the closest residential locations.
- Amplification shall not be audible further than a half block outside the park. The decibel level will therefore not exceed 70 dBA at any unaffiliated receiver. The Applicant or a representative shall monitor and reduce level to meet the above standards.
- Amplification is to cease at 10:00 p.m. SHARP on Friday, June 30th and Saturday, July 1st, and at 7:00 p.m. SHARP on Sunday, July 2nd.
- Sound levels will be reduced upon request.
- Applicant will supply notification of the event all neighbors within a one block radius at least one week prior to the event. Notification will include a phone number that neighbors can call to reach the Applicant to discuss questions before the event and to report concerns of excessive noise during the event.
- Applicant will notify the Noise Office at (503) 823-7350 of any complaints they receive. The Applicant will keep a record of how they responded to concerns raised by the community in order to report their actions back to the Noise Control Office.

To the Applicant:

- Carry this document with you during the activity. This is not a permit to make more noise than is minimally necessary for your needs.
- Violation of the conditions of this variance constitutes grounds for revocation of the variance, and denial of future applications, and may also result in the issuance of citation(s) for violations of City Code.
- If a Police or Noise Control Officer should appear, his/her instructions will supersede this variance and take precedence.
