
- A. Sound checks for systems will be 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Friday, August 25, 2017.
- B. On Saturday, August 26, 2017, music will start at 9:00 a.m. Music will end at 10:00 p.m.
- C. On Sunday, August 27, 2017, music will start at 9:00 a.m. Music will end at 10:00 p.m.
- D. **There are no grace periods on start or end times.**
- E. The applicant will notify the Noise Control Office of any complaints. A mitigation plan will be formulated with the Noise Office.
- F. In terms of collecting noise data for the Noise Office: The applicant or a representative will be required to measure the following parameters and work to save the files once per act: Two minute measurement periods for compliance. Capture the following noise descriptors, Lmax and Lmin; the L1, L10, and L50; and the Leq.
- G. Sound levels may not exceed 75dBA, with peaks to 80 dBA. These measurements are based on an instantaneous one second maximum measurement. Sound will be measured with an A meter rating and a FAST meter response.
- H. Measurements shall be completed on the West side of Naito Parkway in front of the Hotel Rose. Make sure to make notes of the general period of time when the traffic was and influence. There will be periods of time where traffic is not an impact along Naito. Please make sure to have the meter operator keep good notes.
- I. Applicant must supply the nearest receivers (Marriot and Hotel Rose) with a telephone number of a live person to reach with concerns.
- J. The sound level measurements will be supplied to the Noise Control Office within 2 weeks, 14 calendar days, following the event, and include any complaints, any actions taken and response to complaints.
- K. Readings will also be made available upon request of the Noise Office during the event.

To the Applicant:

1. Carry this document with you during the activity. This is not a permit to make more noise than is minimally necessary for your needs.
2. Violation of the conditions of this variance constitutes grounds for revocation of the variance, and denial of future applications, and may also result in the issuance of citation(s) for violations of City Code.
3. **If a Police or Noise Control Officer should appear, his/her instructions will supersede this variance and take precedence.**
