PIR – Review a request from Dave Sweeney, representing Friends of Portland International Raceway, for a race at the Portland Parks enterprise-zone type property known as Portland International Raceway (PIR). The request is for a one-year variance for the 58 th Rose Cup Races featuring the Pirelli World Challenge and Vintage Racing Groups. The variance request is for the dates between July 12, 2018 and July 15, 2018. If approved would use up one of four annual race variances available in Portland to operate at the decibel limit of 110 dBA (FAST) as measured at 50 feet from the racing vehicles.
