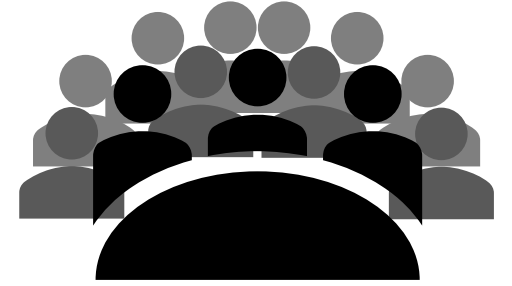
City Bodies Survey Results



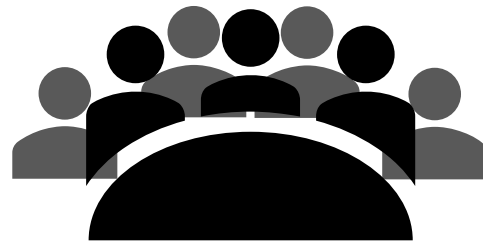

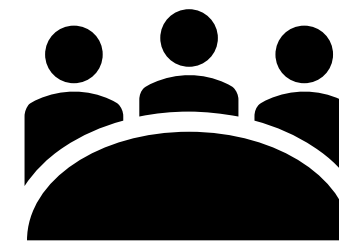

Uniform application:

- mandatory conflict of interest disclosure;
- confidential demographic information.



Application Form

Governing documents will include:

- Limited service up to eight consecutive years;
- Two years wait once completion;
- Exit survey;
- Three unexcused absence.
