Application for the above has been reviewed by the Noise Control Officer, City of Portland, and is hereby:

Approved, with the following conditions:

- A. Operation times for the variance dates are as follows: July 25, 26, 27, 28, and 29, 2018 from 12:00 p.m. (noon) to 10:00 p.m.
- B. On July 25, 26, and 27, 2018, sound levels from 12:00 p.m. (noon) up to 5:00 p.m. may not exceed 65 dBA (peaks to 70 dBA), as measured on the west side of Naito Parkway. From 5:00 p.m. up to 10:00 p.m., sound levels may not exceed 70 dBA (peaks to 75 dBA), as measured on the west side of Naito Parkway (this also pertains to the Brewers Dinner on Wednesday, July 25, 2018).
- C. On Saturday, July 28, 2018, sound levels from 12:00 p.m. (noon) up to 10:00 p.m. may not exceed 70 dBA (peaks to 75 dBA), as measured on the west side of Naito Parkway. Sound will be measured with an A meter weighting and a FAST meter response.
- D. On Sunday, July 29, 2018, sound levels from 12:00 p.m. (noon) up to 6:30 p.m. may not exceed 70 dBA (peaks to 75 dBA), as measured on the west side of Naito Parkway. Sound will be measured with an A meter weighting and a FAST meter response.
- E. Sound level monitoring on the west side of Naito Parkway is to be performed by the applicant, or an appointed party, twice during each afternoon, and twice during each evening of the festival. A set of sound level measurements shall include: a reading on the west side of SW Naito Parkway at SW Stark; a reading on the west side of SW Naito Parkway between SW Oak and SW Pine; and a reading on the west side of SW Naito Parkway between SW Pine and SW Ash. Measurements at the sound board are to be correlated via walkie-talkie and will be included for the entire set of readings. For example, a sound level reading at Naito Parkway at 8:30 PM will have a correlating measurement at X feet from the stage for the exact same time period.


- F. The recorded measurements are to be submitted, as a summary and legible report, to the Noise Control Office, by August 17, 2018. The person(s) monitoring sound shall also do general screening for compliance of the remaining areas along SW Naito Parkway. No sound level measurements will be required for the general monitoring. The recorded logs should be immediately available during the event for the Noise Control Officer to review.
- G. The Applicant also needs to be sensitive of the sound levels from any radio stations that are using speakers as part of their corporate promotions. Sound levels from radio station amplification and promotions shall not exceed 64 dBA on the west side of Naito Parkway during the duration of the event.

To the Applicant:

- 1. Carry this document with you during the activity. This is not a permit to make more noise than is minimally necessary for your needs.
- 2. Violation of the conditions of this variance constitutes grounds for revocation of the variance, and denial of future applications, and may also result in the issuance of citation(s) for violations of City Code.
- 3. **If a Police or Noise Control Officer should appear, his/her instructions will supersede this variance and take precedence.**
