Application for the above has been reviewed by the Noise Control Officer, City of Portland, and is hereby:

Approved, with the following conditions:

- A. Applicant will work to finish fireworks by 10:45 p.m.
- B. Neighbors within five block radius to be notified of fireworks in advance of the date of the variance.
- C. Permittee to maintain student volunteers or campus security on hand to respond to complaints of noise from neighbors.
- D. The Applicant will remember to apply as a high impact event for all future firework events.
- E. Applicant will notify the Noise Control Office at (503) 823-7350 of any noise complaints received.
- F. Speakers to face away from closest residences.
- G. Music and amplified sounds will not be audible more than two blocks from the event until 10:00 p.m. After 10:00 p.m. amplification shall not be audible further than one block from the source of the noise. (One block = 250 feet maximum.)
- H. More modest forms of amplification to end at 1:00 a.m. SHARP on Friday and Saturday.
- I. Sound levels will be reduced upon request. Responding volunteers or campus security shall also routinely drive to the perimeter of the school property after 10 PM and park their vehicle with the engine shut off. The person shall listen for excessive bass. If the bass is audible in the closed window vehicle, then the sound person will be notified to reduce the bass.

To the Applicant:

1. Carry this document with you during the activity. This is not a permit to make more noise than is minimally necessary for your needs.
2. Violation of the conditions of this variance constitutes grounds for revocation of the variance, and denial of future applications, and may also result in the issuance of citation(s) for violations of City Code.
3. If a Police or Noise Control Officer should appear, his/her instructions will supersede this variance and take precedence.
