


Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) has a tool that allows you to sign up and receive news and information to connect the people of Portland with opportunities for engagement around City decision making and public policy, community livability and safety, and promotion of networking and collaboration amongst communities and neighborhoods.

This service is known as **ONI Notification** and you will need to go through the subscription process if you want to receive these updates. The City’s news subscription service allows you to receive **daily, weekly or monthly** updates from the City regarding a number of different categories of City related news.

So if you are interested in receiving notifications from ONI via this subscription service follow these steps:

- Go to the City website at www.portlandoregon.gov and click “Sign In” in the upper right hand corner of the screen.




If you already have an account, sign in with your user name and password (if you can’t recall your password there is a password remind option you can click). If you don’t have an account there is an option to create one.

- Once signed in, scroll to the very bottom of the screen and click the “Subscribe” link under the Access header and then you will see a pop up box where you can select any of the category types of updates you would like to receive.



Simply mark any categories you wish to subscribe to. If you would like to receive notifications from ONI, make sure the "ONI Notification" box is selected, then scroll to the bottom and click “Submit”.



In addition to the ONI Notification subscription there is a Geographic Subscription that is very popular and useful for people who want to just receive information related to a particular geographic area of the city. **We hope you will subscribe as this is a key way for us to disseminate information of interest to community members!**
