

Non-Park Use of Park Property Permit Insurance Requirements

The following are the requirements for insurance certification needed from anyone doing work on Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) Property. Certificates of Insurance are required for any firm doing work on PP&R property – in conjunction with the required Non-Park Use of Park Property Permit - whether they are being permitted directly by PP&R or are a subcontractor to someone being permitted.

A complete application includes the following insurance information from all firms doing work on Park Property (both contractors and subs)	
Insurance	Certificate of Insurance indicating:
	1. Proof of Workers Compensation Insurance
	2. Current Commercial General Liability Coverage
	3. Automobile Liability Insurance
Details	The Certificate must include the following things:
	 Coverage for "The City of Portland, its officers, agents and employees" as additional insured.
	 Specific reference to your project and the park by name in the comments section.
	 Attach additional insured endorsement form (CG2012 or similar).
	 The Certificate Holder must be listed as either Portland Parks & Recreation, or the City of Portland, at the address as listed below.
	 Coverage limits must be equal to or exceed the following:
	> \$2,000,000 for personal injury to each person,
	➤ \$2,000,000 for each occurrence, and
	➤ \$2,000,000 for each occurrence involving property damage;
	OR
	➤ A single limit policy of not less than \$4,000,000 covering all claims per
	occurrence.
	 Automobile insurance coverage for any damages or injuries arising out of the use of
	automobiles or other motorized vehicles by the Permittee and its contractors, if any.
	o 30 days written notice to the certificate holder in the case of cancellation of the policy
	before the expiration date.
Exceptions	o If your organization is self-insured, we need a letter or Certificate stating so,
	demonstrating that you have coverage in the required amounts.
	o If you are a sole proprietor with no employees, or if you otherwise claim to be exempt
	from Workers Compensation Insurance, you will need to complete the City's Workers'
	Compensation Questionnaire.
	 If your firm is being covered by an Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP) please provide documentation to that affect.
