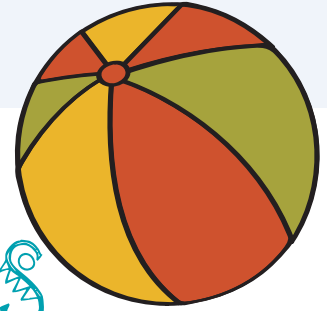

Important Notes to Remember

- Camper information forms must be completed & returned to the office before the first day of camp.
- Campers must bring a lunch each day.
- Late arrivals can not be accommodated. The group will be boarding Tri-met shortly after 9am each day.
- If a camper misses the departure time, a parent may escort them to meet the group at the destination or will need to go home for the day. We will not be able to give refunds for missed camp days due to late arrival.
- Campers will spend time outside each day rain or shine. Please dress for weather.
- Campers must supply their own sunscreen. Please apply before arriving to camp.
- To request accommodations, please contact PP&R's AIR program ten business days before your first day of camp.
- **On Tuesdays:** Campers must be able to walk unassisted on uneven ground. Comfortable walking shoes needed!
- **On Wednesdays:** Campers will need a swim suit & towel for swimming or playing in various fountains.
- **On Thursdays:** Campers must be able to participate in physically active games that include running, throwing, jumping, etc.
