Applicant is worried trees might fail in a windstorm.

NARRATIVE DESCRIBING REASON FOR DECISION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Permit was granted to remove one 28" Douglas fir that was within 10 feet of a structure upon appeal review. The remaining three trees are appealed to the Urban Forestry Commission.

No evidence provided or observed of a health or structural problems with the trees that warrants removal. Recommend denial unless evidence is provided.
