



Duniway Park Project Update September 2016

Hello Neighbors, Friends, and Users of Duniway Park!

WE ARE MOVING....dirt that is.

It is getting really messy around Duniway Park. Thank you for your patience. Construction efforts for Duniway Park Track and Field improvements are currently on schedule with an anticipated completion **November 2016**. **For safety precautions, please adhere to all construction signs at the park.**

The park improvements include:

- Eight lane 400 meter track with associated throwing and jumping events, such as high jump, long jump, pole vault
- Synthetic turf field
- Pedestrian lighting around track



Construction Process

Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) removed the old soccer field and track surface. We framed the inside edge of the track's curb to shape the curb and poured concrete to complete the process. The curb has a drain as well. There is a large stock pile of gravel in the middle of the field. This gravel will be utilized for the drainage system underneath the field.





Hazard Tree Removal

On Monday, August 29, PP&R City Arborist completed tree pruning around the shot put location (SW end of the track). At the same time PP&R City Arborist identified a dead tree (Incense Cedar, *Calocedrus decurrens*) on site and removed it. We located the dead tree on Sheridan Street, and it had turned completely brown over the course of the summer.
